I like playing tennis**MORE THAN**.....playing squash.

41. Jenny's exam results were better than anyone else's in the class. **the**

Jenny's exam results were the best in the class.

42. "Put your toys away!" Mum told Samuel. **to**

Mum told Samuel to put his toys away.

43. Michael is too short to play volleyball. **isn't**

Michael isn't tall enough to play volleyball.

44. There weren't many children at the party. **a**

Only a few (children) came to the party.

45. You can't park in this area! **not**

You're not allowed to park in this area.

46. Sally ended her relationship with Fred last week. **up**

Sally and Fred broke up last week.

47. Someone has stolen my I-Phone! **has**

My I-Phone has been stolen !

48. If it doesn't rain, we'll go for a picnic. **Unless**

Unless it rains, we'll go for a picnic.

49. She left the train at Victoria Station. **got**

She got off / got out of the train at Victoria station.

50. The journey from Manchester to London lasts three hours. **It**

It takes three hours to get from Manchester to London.
